General Information Stallion Owners

- **Rule Change:** If a stallion service does not sell at the stallion auction or by Dec. 30th of the current year, then the stallion owner will not receive a free entry into the futurity of choice when the foals are three years old unless the stallion owner wishes to buy back the breeding for the minimum fee of \$500 and then the stallion owner will receive two free entries into the futurity when the foals are three years old.
- Stallion Owners Donate a Breeding to the Futurities: This breeding is sold during a mail-in and/or auction.
- Stallion Owners must donate a breeding each year in order for foals to be eligible (if they skip a year foals are not eligible the year they become eligible from the year skipped. For example if they skipped the 2007 breeding season, foals are not eligible to participate in 2011)
- Stallion Owners are given a free entry in one of the futurities the coinciding year that they donate the breeding. (3 year old year)
- Stallion Owners must nominate the mare/foal before it is born for their free entry.
- Stallion Owners can purchase their own breeding.
- Stallion Owners are given a free entry into the futurity of their choice. (Regional entry fee and other fees still apply)

Breedings

- Donated breedings are sold during a mail-in and/or live auction.
- The highest bidder at closing of auction purchases the breeding.
- The proceeds from the breedings are put into a savings account until the 3 year old year of the auction.
- The high bidders are given a free entry into a futurity of their choice. (Regional entry fee and other fees still apply)
- The high bidders must nominate the foal before it is born for their free entry.
- High bidders must declare mare at time of breeding.
- If high bidder can't get mare in foal they may change mares one time the same year.
- This mare also needs to be nominated/declared.
- The inability to get a mare in foal is not the responsibility of the futurity and will result in no futurity entry and no money will be refunded.
- The highest bidders must make arrangements for breeding their mare with the stallion owners. (Shipped semen and/or mare care is the responsibility of the high bidders)
- If a foal dies before being eligible for its futurity then owners will be allowed to replace this foal with another foal owned by them and sired by a nominated stallion.

Other Entries

- Any foal by a nominated stallion will be eligible for any of the futurities by paying an entry fee.
- Open futurities are for any purebred or half arabian 3 year old.
- ATR classes are for any purebred or half arabian 4 and 5 year olds.
- Foals by non- nominated stallions may participate for \$100 additional fee on top of other futurity entry fees.
They will not be eligible for any stallion service monies. They are eligible for other prizes and added money.

Proceeds

- All monies collected from each breeding season are put toward prize money when foals become eligible at three years of age less the 10% withheld for advertising and office charges.
- 10% of all proceeds are kept to use for office fees and advertising.
- All monies will be kept in savings accounts in order to draw interest.

**** (Auction Monies) are only available to:**

- a: The foal from the resulting breeding that is auctioned at Regionals and
- b: One foal from the stallion owner that is nominated for that year.

**** Nominated stallion foals other than the above are eligible for added prize money but not for the auction money.**

Bids

- Bidding is on a mail-in and/or live auction basis.
- As bids come in the high bidder will be notified that they have been outbid which allows them to increase their bid.
- Bidding closes February 1st and high bidders are notified.
- Stallions whose breeding has not sold will be left open for bids until it does sell.

Entry Fees

Foals by nominated stallions can enter with the following fees:

- 3 Year olds \$100.00 nomination fee by April 15th. Double this fee after April 16th.
- \$150.00 second nomination fee due postmarked by May 30th Double fee if after June 1st.
- 4 & 5 ATR classes \$100.00 nomination fee by April 15th. Double this fee after April 16th
- \$50.00 second nomination fee due postmarked by May 30th. Double this fee after June 1st
- Regular show entry due at first closing of Region 5 entries.
- Foals by non-nominated stallions must pay an additional \$100.00 which may be made in two payments of \$50.00 each. If late, then fee is doubled.



Money add-back:

Money from entry fees will be paid out as follows:

- 90% payback in classes
- 10% held back for advertising and operating costs.

Payouts

➤ Placings to 10th place

Money split as follows

1 entry = 100%

1-2 entries= 60% - 40%

1-3 entries= 50% - 30% - 20%

1-4 entries= 50% - 25% - 15% - 10%

1-5 entries= 40% - 30% - 15% - 10% - 5%

1-6 entries= 35% - 25% - 15% - 15% - 5% - 5%

1-7 entries= 30% - 20% - 15% - 15% - 10% - 5% - 5%

8 or more entries payouts to 7th place only

Rules

- The pleasure futurities will be run according to AHA Performance Futurity rules.
- No qualifications are needed for the Futurities.
- All disputes will be settled by the Futurity commission.

****ATR Maturities open to 4 and 5 year olds to be shown in a snaffle or bosal.**

****The ATR Maturities are for hunter and western only no country at this time.**

****Rules are the same other than there will be no auction money distributed, only added money and prizes.**
