AHA MEMBERSHIP CARDS & HORSE REGISTRATION PAPERS: Please do not send copies of AHA or USEF membership cards or horse registration papers. My software links to AHA and USEF but make certain you type numbers correctly! Remember to include the prefix (1A, for example) to Half-Arabian numbers and if Canadian registered, CAHR or CPAR. Copies of sales contracts and lease agreements will need to be sent, if applicable. As always, be sure to have hard copies with you at the show along with horse vaccination records.

AMATEUR relationship to horse owner line on the entry is important; especially when the last name is different. Please complete it if showing in AAOTR, AOTR, or JOTR classes.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS: Please see "Entry Requirements and Need to Know" on page 3.

EARLY ARRIVALS must be coordinated with the Show Manager, Carrie Olson. An early arrival fee will be charged.

ENTERING THE SHOW: Please read the "Entry Requirements & Need to Know" information on page 3. Phone Pat if you would like assistance or have questions: 253.279.6722.

FUTURITIES: The Young Sport Horse Jackpot Futurity Rules and Entry Form are on page 10. Both require entry and payment in addition to entering the Region 5 SH Championship Show. Don't miss the deadlines!

HIGH POINT AWARDS: One award to the high point junior and one award to the high point adult amateur. All JTR, AATR, ATR and AOTR classes will count and you are automatically entered. Generously sponsored by the Marcinkowski's of Hidden Meadows Arabians, be sure to thank them! And rumor has it, Scott will be cooking breakfast as usual! Bays Unlimited is sponsoring the High Point Walk/Trot 10 & Under.

PAYMENT OF ENTRIES: Checks or PayPal. There is a 4% user fee for PayPal. The entry form will calculate payment amount due by check or PayPal. Either must be paid/mailed with entry. Your entry will not be processed until payment is received. This also means you will not be scheduled for an in-hand or dressage ride time until payment is received. If after close date of May 31, post fees will be applied.

RV PARKING 2024: Full hook-ups are limited & are \$40 per night. Electric & water hookups are \$35 per night. RV's, LQ trailers, nor trailers of any type are allowed to park in an RV spot without paying the fees. Make reservations beginning May 28. Phone 360-805-6706. Full hook-ups must be coordinated with Carrie Olson.

USEF RULE FOR PARENTS SIGNING FOR MINOR TRAINER: a parent or guardian signing for a minor who signs the entry form as the trainer of a horse, must have a Competing USEF membership AND be current on Safe Sport training.

USEF SAFE SPORT: Be sure you are current on USEF Safe Sport Training before the show. Check your status at https://www.usef.org/safe-sport. You will not be entered in the show if not current at the time I process your entry.

USEF SHOW PASS: A Show Pass in lieu of a competing membership (those showing in amateur classes must have a Competing Membership) must now be purchased on-line at USEF. One per year is allowed.

NOT QUALIFIED AT THE CLOSE OF ENTRIES?

Enter the classes you will be qualifying for AND on the Qualification form, make a note of the corresponding class titles you have entered at the show you are using to qualify.

Give the name and date of the qualifying show. Confirm qualification via email asap.

^{*}Office, AHA & USEF Federation fees are required to be paid for every horse entered. ** A returned check will be charged \$50. We will notify you and cash will be required for the entry total plus bank fees and the \$50 fee before your entries are released. A check will not be deposited a second time.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS - NEED TO KNOW

ENTRY is to be made via email using the form in this Prize List. Make certain you have updated your Adobe Reader. Please double check that all numbers you type in are accurate.

FORMS: Download the forms & SAVE! Using the tab key, navigate through the fields. (You can manually move your cursor as well.) Enter your class number and the fee for the class. The form will calculate the fees as you enter. When completed, SAVE the form and attach to an email to pathough07@gmail.com. The Entry Form is one horse per form but if you own another and are entering it, save a copy of the first form (title file with horse name) and just overtype the horse info, classes entered and change the rider information if different. No need to re-enter owner, trainer, etc. Save this form with the new horse's name to attach to the email. Repeat as needed. In other words, overtype any fields you need to, the others will save. "Saving" is the key to success.

SIGNATURE PAGES are required to be emailed with the entries. Be sure to sign for all involved. As stated on the forms, electronic signatures are binding. The normal back of entry form, AHA/USEF release: each owner, trainer, rider, and parent/guardian for a minor owner, trainer, or rider.

- 1) The entry form, front and back with all signatures
- 2) The USEF Waiver of Liability: EACH owner, trainer, rider, and parent/guardian for a minor owner, trainer or rider person on the entry form must sign and send their own form. If you are the owner, trainer, and rider, then one form.
- 3) A completed qualification form unless you are only entering classes which do not require qualification.
- 4) Remember, a parent or guardian signing for a minor who is on the entry form as the TRAINER of the horse must be a USEF Competing member AND be current on Safe Sport Training.
- 5) Only one person in your group should send a stabling form but write your stabling request on the space on the entry form.

MEMBERSHIP CARDS, HORSE PAPERS: Copies of AHA, USEF cards and horse papers do NOT need to be sent. A "Competition" AHA membership is required for everyone (including Walk/Trot riders) at this Regional Championship Show. A "Competing" USEF membership (except Walk/Trot 10 & under riders) is required or a Non-Member fee of \$45 will be required. A USEF Show Pass must now be purchased online at USEF and is limited to one per year per person. All adult riders entering amateur classes must have amateur certification and therefore a competing membership. I'll be checking for Amateur Certification AND that Safe Sport Training is current. Junior exhibitors who are 18 years of age must also complete Safe Sport. Copies of registration papers are not required; just make certain you enter numbers correctly and HA/AA numbers must be preceded by 1A, 2A etc. The owner(s) on the entry form needs to match the owner(s) on the horse's papers. If purchasing on contract or leasing, include that agreement. If competing in Western Dressage, a WDAA membership is required for the owner, trainer and each rider or a non-member fee of \$35 must be paid.

PAYMENT: Checks or PayPal. A 4% user fee will be added to your entry amount if you use PayPal. The entry form will calculate it for you. Payment is due the same day the entry is made whether by PayPal or check. **Your entry will not be processed until payment is received. If received after the close date, post entry fees will be applied.**

<u>CANADIAN</u> exhibitors who are EC Sport License holders in good standing and with a Bronze, Silver, Gold or Platinum Sport License will be given a USEF Competing Membership at no cost for the purpose of competing in USEF licensed competitions. All USEF Competing Members who are 18 years of age or older must annually complete the SafeSport Training provided by the US Center for Safe Sport before being allowed to compete. For information about obtaining a USEF Competition membership, EC Sport License holders should contact <u>sportlicences@equestrian.ca</u> or <u>memberservices@usef.org.</u> USEF rules for amateur status apply for all competitions licensed by USEF, and EC rules for amateur status apply for all competitions sanctioned by EC. **This USEF issued number is to be used on your entry form.**

It is important to note that individuals holding dual memberships (both EC and USEF) must complete the education requirements for both National Federations.

IN-HAND INFORMATION

- Entries open 0001 May 1. In-Hand times may be limited, so please email your entry early, but not before 0001 May 1. Entries received earlier will be returned. The close of entries is May 31 at midnight. If slots fill, a wait list will be established, and available slots offered from it in the order received.
- In-Hand classes will be run in class schedule order and times assigned. Assigned times will be posted on move-in day at the show. Please check in at the gate when your class is called. Every effort will be made to schedule Western Dressage rides to avoid conflicts with horses that have also entered In-Hand. ONLY the paddock master has the authority to assist you. If you are not at the gate and checked in prior to your time, you will have missed your class unless your conflict has been resolved with the paddock master in advance.
- The Supreme In-Hand class is open to first place horses from every in-hand class except the two futurity classes. There is no entry fee nor a requirement to show back. Judges will confer and choose one champion. Not an AHA class. Do not enter this class on the entry form; first place horses will be entered by the office.

AMATEUR OWNER FAMILY/UNRELATED OWNER DEFINITION: Registration papers of horses entered in amateur owner and junior owner classes must in the name of the competitor or a member of the competitor's family or if unrelated owners then the following new rule applies: two non-related owners are now able to co-own and show in owner classes IF 1)the ownership is an AND ownership not an OR ownership 2) no family member of a professional may enter into this relationship 3) "non family owners" are defined as two distinct individuals who are not related as family as defined by USEF or EC. 4) the horse must be registered with one of the five Registries in US or Canada or another approved registry. 5) family members of these two co-owners are NOT permitted to show in owner classes. 6) both co-owners must be members of USEF or EC and hold valid amateur cards. 7) co-ownership is limited to two distinct individuals – no farms or business entities. Please see USEF AR110.4.e for complete requirements and limitations. Horses registered in a farm, ranch, syndicate, partnership or corporation name may be shown in Amateur Owner classes provided the family is the sole owner of the farm or entity as defined by USEF rules.) The sale of a horse does not eliminate this registration requirement. Contracts of Sale or Bill of Sale will not be accepted for owner classes.

ARABIAN & HA/AA TWO YEAR & UNDER JACKPOT FUTURITY FILLY, COLT, GELDING: See page 10 in this Prize List for information and rules on the non-rated Jackpot classes. The Jackpot classes are not approved by AHA. There are deadlines to meet to enter the classes.

ARENAS: Arena footing is sandy loam or sand. Measurements are: Main arena – 120'x248', Covered Warm-up – 100' x 200', Front sand ring – 128' x 254', NE sand ring – 130' x 200', sand ring between barns 105/106 – 73' x 164'. Several sand lunge rings are available.

AWARDS: Region 5 Champions & Reserve Champions will receive a prize and a neck garland. The remainder of the Top Five will receive a Top Five streamer ribbon and plaque. A full Top Five will be awarded regardless of the number of entries in a class. However, only awards made to the top 50% of the class (rounded up and not to exceed 5 awards) will receive Arabian Breeders Sweepstakes payouts, AHA Horse Achievement Awards, Amateur Achievement Awards, High Point Horse Achievement Awards, High Point Amateur Achievement Awards & Distance Award points.

AWARDS ROOM: Located at the out-gate corner of the main arena. Champion and Reserve Champion awards must be picked up and signed for at the awards room. Open during sessions. Unclaimed awards will not be mailed.

BIKES, MOPEDS, ROLLERBLADES, RAZORS, SCOOTERS are not allowed inside the fairgrounds fences to comply with fairground rules.

CLASS CONFLICTS: Exhibitors are cautioned against entering the same horse in successive classes. Due to full schedules, the gate will not be held for riders beyond the normal gate hold allowed. No refunds will be given due to class conflicts.

DOGS: Must be on a leash (except when in RV's) and under control at all times. They are not allowed inside arenas, rings or lunging areas or restrooms. Owners must clean up after their dog. The Gate Attendant will report to the show office if there are any issues with dogs running free or aggressive dogs.

DRESSAGE WARM-UP: Arena 101 is the dedicated dressage warm-up arena when Dressage classes begin. The competition rings (Main Arena and The Covered Outdoor Arena) will be available for warm-up as much as possible. Please vacate promptly when requested.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW: FROM THE SOUTH: I-5 North then merge onto I-405 N via exit 154 toward Renton and Bellevue. Merge onto WA 522 East via Exit 23 toward US 2 to Woodinville/Wenatchee. Turn right onto US 2. Turn right onto 179th Ave SE. The trailer entrance is approximately .3 mile on right. **FROM THE NORTH:** I-5 South to Seattle then merge onto I405 S via exit 182 to Bellevue/Renton. Merge onto WA522 East via Exit 23A toward WA 202/Monroe/Wenatchee. Turn right onto US 2/Stevens Pass Hwy. Turn right onto 179th Ave SE. The trailer entrance is approximately .3 mile on the right.

DRUGS & MEDICATION: Refer to USEF Chapter 4. Medication Report Forms are to be completed on line at www.usef.org.

FEED: Feed is available from a number of area retailers. Check at the office for information.

General Rules & Information, cont'd

FOOD: Food and beverages will be available from concessions on the fairgrounds during show hours. If closing early, announcements will be made.

GATE/GATE HOLDS: When it is found that a gate hold must be requested by an exhibitor, such request shall be made to the Paddock Master prior to the close of judging of the class immediately before the class requiring the gate hold. The reason for the request m ust be stated. The gate-hold will be a maximum of three (3) minutes. Appropriate warning will be given to all exhibitors if there is a gate hold in effect. When horses are competing collectively, if a first horse does not enter the in-gate ready to participate within one minute from when the class is called into the ring, a warning is issued. a. Exhibitors will then have one additional minute to start the steady stream of horses into the in-gate. b. If no horses have entered the gate at the conclusion of the additional one minute, the gate shall be closed and the class is deemed concluded. c. Once the first horse has entered the in-gate, a steady stream of horses must be maintained. d. Should the steady stream be broken after the two minutes have elapsed, the gate shall be closed and judging will commence. e. A steady stream is defined as a constant flow of horses moving forward through the in-gate with a reasonable and safe distance between them (i.e. two to four horse or horse and buggy lengths in between). f. Show Management in conjunction with the Steward may deviate from this procedure as circumstances warrant. A starting order will be established in all classes in which horses compete individually and one minute allowed for an entry to enter the ring.

GOLF CARTS: Are allowed with proof of insurance on file in the show office. Please read and comply with the USEF Motorized vehicles rule below. Please park in golf cart designated areas.

LUNGING: Lunging areas will be provided. Please look for "Lunging Allowed" signs. Lunging is not allowed in the main ring, the covered outdoor ring, the front sand ring, or the NE sand ring.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, g olf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a temporary license may operate the above-described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

OFFICE: The show office is located at the North end of the main arena. The office may be closed during meal hours. Office hours are as follows: June 26 from 11 AM to 9 PM. June 27 – June 29 from 7:30 AM to 30 minutes after the last class.

PARKING: Parking is not allowed in the fenced fairgrounds area. Truck & trailers must move immediately after unloading.

PAYMENT OF ENTRIES: Checks or PayPal. There is a 4% user fee for PayPal. The entry form will calculate payment amount due by check or PayPal. Either must be paid/mailed on the day of entry. Your entry will not be processed until payment is received. This also means you will not be scheduled for an in-hand or dressage ride time until payment is received. If after close date of May 31, post fees will be applied.

PRIZE MONEY: AHA Sweepstakes monetary awards will be paid by AHA in accordance with program rules.

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR: All juniors riding in hunter, jumper and hunter seat equitation sections, while riding anywhere on the competition grounds, must wear properly fitted protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM/SEI standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place. Any exhibitor may wear protective headgear (ASTM/SEI) and/or a protective safety vest, specifically designed for use in equestrian sport in any division or class without penalty from the judge. The Federation recommends that the vest meet or surpass the current ASTM standard or be certified by the Safety Equipment Institute.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR REGIONALS: The Qualification form on page 22 must be sent with each entry.

RV/CAMPER PARKING: Reservations will be taken beginning May 28. Phone 360-805-6706. Please park in your assigned space. All towing and additional vehicles must be parked in the parking areas; no vehicles or horse trailers are allowed in an RV spot. Charges are \$40 for full hook-up (limited), \$35 for water/electric and \$30 for space with no hook-up. Full hook-ups must be coordinated with Carrie Olson.

SCORING SYSTEMS: All classes are judged by a single judge.

STABLING: Stalls are 10 x 10, either metal or wood, and matted. Doors are either full sliding or top and bottom.

STALLIONS: Stallions may be shown by Juniors in any class except Walk/Trot/Jog 10 & under classes.

SUBSTITUTION OF JUDGES: Region 5 reserves the right to change, re-assign or hire additional judges if the need arises.

USEF AMATEUR CERTIFICATION FOR EQUINE CANADA AMATEUR MEMBERS: Be sure to certify your amateur status when joining USEF under the new membership rules.


USEF NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION: If membership documentation is not submitted to the competition and the competition cannot verify such information, the exhibitor will be required to purchase a Show Pass for the fee of \$45.00. Purchase of a Show Pass fee does NOT allow a competitor to show in amateur classes. To show in an amateur class, a competitor must provide proof of membership with amateur certification. **A Show Pass must now be purchased online at www.usef.org and only one per year is allowed.**

USEF MEMBERSHIP: Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above, Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage Competitions, Endurance Rides and Vaulting Competitions: (See GR828.4 of the Federation rules). Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent, at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR231) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes

USEF SAFE SPORT POLICY: As of January 1, 2019, if you are a USEF competing member 18 years of age or older you are required to take the core Safe Sport Training within 30 days of activating your membership. Take the Safe Sport Training at www.usef.org by logging into your member dashboard. Please remember to complete the most recent required course before your due date. Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for Safe Sport training requirements to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for Safe Sport Code. USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org. Any questions not answered by the website should be directed to USEF at 859.258.2472.

USEF VACCINATION RULE: effective 12/01/15, all horses competing at a USEF recognized show must have proof of current vaccinations for rhino and flu. Exhibitors must furnish proof upon the request of show management. No need to send with entry.

Membership Requirements for USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized Competitions:

Owners and riders, including foreign riders

and owners who are not residents of the US, wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition as a rider or owner/lessee, must have either a USDF Group Membership (GM), Participating Membership (PM), or have a USDF Non-Member (NM) identification number and pay the USDF Non-Member (NM) fee. (Note: USDF Business Members can own horses but cannot compete as riders with their USDF Business Membership.)

Horses competing at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions must have either a USDF Horse Identification (HID) number or a USDF Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR). Proper credentials or verification certificates must be presented to the competition secretary.

Riders and owners wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition, and not able to present the competition secretary with verification of a USDF membership or NM identification, and USDF LHR or USDF HID, must complete a USDF Competition Affidavit Form and pay the \$5 affidavit filing fee. A copy of a completed affidavit form from another competition may also be used for verification purposes for up to 60 days. (Exception: Affidavits cannot be used at Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championships.)

Exceptions:

- Horses competing only in Individual Breed Classes (IBCs) at DSHB competitions, sires and dams of horses in DSHB group classes, where those
 sires or dams are not actually competing in the same competition, horses competing only in breed restricted dressage or DSHB classes at
 Regular Competitions (e.g. all Arabian, all Friesian, or all Morgan classes), or in USDF Introductory Level tests, pas de deux or quadrille, are
 exempt from this requirement. Also exempt are horses ridden in leadline, exhibitions, games and races, classes for 4-H members, walk-trot,
 academy, and opportunity classes.
- Riders and owners/lessees competing only in classes which are exempt from the USDF HID requirements are also exempt from the USDF NM
 identification number and NM fee requirements. Also exempt are handlers of horses competing in DSHB In-Hand or Group classes.

Memberships Defined

Participating Membership (PM): A membership issued to an individual directly by USDF. The membership year is December 1 through November 30. PMs are available for 1-year (\$90), 5-years (\$360), or life (\$1,800). A USDF Youth Participating Membership (YPM) is available for individuals who have not reached their 21st birthday by December 1 of the current membership year (\$72). A PM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and to participate as a rider and/or owner/lessee for all Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards and the Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championship program.

Group Membership (GM): A membership issued to an individual by USDF when the member name and dues are submitted to USDF through an affiliate Group Member Organization (GMO). The GM year begins December 1 and ends November 30. A GM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and participate in the USDF Rider Awards Program and the USDF Regional Schooling Show Awards Program. **Business Membership (BM):** A membership that runs December 1 through November 30 and is issued to a business or organization directly by USDF. The USDF BM (\$240) offers a wider variety of advertising benefits. BMs satisfy requirements of horse ownership only.

Non-Member (NM) Identification Number: For each USDF NM owner/lessee and USDF NM rider there will be a USDF NM fee of \$35 per competition that must be collected by the show secretary and submitted to USDF, along with the USDF Report of Fees document and the \$5 affidavit fee and Competition Affidavit Form if the person cannot provide a copy of their USDF NM card. Owners/lessees or riders exempt from the NM number requirements are also exempt from paying the USDF NM fee. If there are multiple owners of a horse and all are NMs, only one of the owners must pay the NM fee. If the horse has at least one owner who is a current USDF PM, GM, or BM there is no NM fee assessed. Competition management will be invoiced for all applicable USDF NM fees not received with the USDF post-competition paperwork, along with a report listing all USDF NMs. Competition management is then required to submit the NM fees within 30 days to the USDF. An individual with a USDF NM identification number is not eligible for any USDF membership benefits. Once a USDF NM number has been assigned, a USDF NM card can be obtained from the USDF website.

Horse Identification (HID) Number: A one-time tracking number for horses (\$35). Scores earned by a horse with an HID number will be recorded but will NOT be counted towards Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards. A horse with an HID number is not eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying or championship classes. An HID number can be upgraded to a Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) for a fee of \$80. If a horse has a USDF LHR it does not need an HID number. An HID number is a one-time fee that does not need to be renewed.

Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR): A horse with an LHR (\$115) is eligible for Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards, and eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying and championship classes, assuming requirements for the owner and rider are met. If a horse has an LHR it does not need an HID number. An LHR does not need to be renewed.

How to Join USDF

Applications for USDF Participating Membership (PM), Business Membership (BM), Horse Identification (HID) number, and Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) may be found in the following locations:

- On the USDF website: www.usdf.org. You can submit the application online or download the form.
- In the show office at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions classified by USEF as Dressage Competitions, and Regular Competitions which are open to all breeds.

The effective date of membership is the date the form and correct fees are received in the USDF office or, if applying at a competition, the date accepted by the competition secretary, provided the application is signed and dated by the competition secretary, member, and/or horse owner on that same day.

USDF Statement on Animal Welfare

The United States Dressage Federation, Inc. (USDF), a federation of individual members and over 100 independent organizations throughout the United States, supports the concept of ethical treatment of animals.

Dressage is a classical method of training horses, based upon the horse's natural responses, as carried out in a gradual, planned program during which the horse's athletic abilities are improved in a systematic manner. As a result, the horse becomes capable, comfortable, and responsive in partnership with the rider without the use of force. Dressage competition at various levels of achievement is the ultimate test of the training program to determine whether the desired harmony between horse and rider has been achieved.

The rules pertaining to dressage competition prohibit the use of artificial appliances, training aids, and drugs, which would force the horse to submit. Instead, the emphasis is upon training and a cooperative partnership with the rider. Major competitions are carefully monitored to assure that there is no unnecessary force or harshness displayed.

Unlike other horse sports in which horses enter training at a relatively immature state, dressage training is usually not seriously begun until the horse is three or four. The top levels of achievement require five or more years of progressive training and it is not unusual to see horses in international competition in their late teens. This, in itself, places a premium on good care and soundness throughout the horse's life.

While supporting the concept of animal welfare in its broadest form, the United States Dressage Federation, Inc., also recognizes that it is unrealistic to ascribe human emotions and responses to the horse which in its wild state is a creature of flight, living a hard and precarious existence. Under domestication, the horse is assured of ample food, water, and shelter, as well as protection against infectious diseases and damaging parasites, thus leading a longer and healthier life with a high rate of survival.

As an educational organization, USDF has numerous programs, which teach people how to pursue the accepted, humane training methods. A program of certifying instructors also emphasizes protecting the horse's welfare in pursuit of dressage training.

AHA ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION

This document waives very important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.
In consideration for AHA permitting me to participate in this Competition, and by signing the entry blank, I agree as follows:
I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in this Competition, as a rider, driver, handler, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, junior exhibitor, or as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I AM FULLY AWARE AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HORSE SPORTS AND PARTICIPATION IN THIS COMPETITION INVOLVE SERIOUS RISK OF HARM INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RISKS OF ACCIDENT, SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, BROKEN BONES, HEAD INJURIES, TRAUMA, PAIN, AND SUFFERING, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE. I ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM TO ME, MY HORSE OR MY PROPERTY.

I AGREE as a Horse Show Participant (or Parent/Guardian of Participant if a minor) to waive all claims which may otherwise arise from, including but not limited to infectious bacteria, viruses, fungi/mold, parasites or other agents which may be present at the Horse Show (and most other outdoor locations) and

limited to infectious bacteria, viruses, fungimold, parasites or other agents which may be present at the Horse Show (and most other outdoor locations) and cause infection in humans, as well as in animals.

I AGREE for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns to release AHA, the Competition, the facilities leased by the Competition and the owner(s) of the facilities, and all of their respective officers, officials, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers, affiliated organizations and insurers (collectively, the "Released Parties") from any and all claims for damage, loss, or injury to myself, other persons, horses or other property belonging to me to the fullest extent permitted by law that arises out of or relates in any way to the Competition and my participation in the Competition INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, DAMAGES, LOSS, OR INJURY RESULTING FROM ANY ACTS, FAILURE TO ACT, NEGLIGENCE OR NEGLECT OF OTHER ENTRANTS, THE RELEASED PARTIES, THEIR CONTRACTORS OR INVITEES, as well as for theft, vandalism, fire, other casualty damage, or damage arising out of any defects in the premises.

I AGREE to indemnify and hold harmless (that is pay all losses, damages, attorneys fees and costs of) the Released Parties from and against any and all claims, demands, penalties, actions, losses, costs, damages, injuries, liabilities and obligations (including attorneys fees) of whatsoever kind and nature, which may be asserted against or incurred by any of them as a result of (1) my participation in the Competition or (2) any act, failure to act, or neglect (a) by me, my agents, employees, riders, handlers, trainers, coaches, drivers, contractors or invitees, or (b) by any animal owned or exhibited by me or

in my custody or control.

I AGREE and represent that I am qualified and eligible to enter and/or participate in the Competition, and every horse I am entering is qualified and

eligible as entered.

I AGREE to accept AS FINAL any decision of AHA, the Show Commission or Show Officials concerning my qualification or the qualification of my horse to enter the Competition or any results of the Competition, except to the extent that the Rules of AHA, the Competition, EC or USEF Equestrian permit a protest or hearing of such decisions. Should a hearing be requested, I agree to accept AS FINAL the decision of the particular hearing body. I agree to release, hold harmless and not to sue AHA, the Competition Sponsor, their officers, directors, employees, volunteers or members concerning any decision of AHA, the Competition, its Show Commission, Show Officials or any hearing body that relates to my qualifications or my horse(s)' qualifications to enter the Competition or any results of the Competition.

I AGREE that AHA has the sole right to control, sell, supervise or give away (or assign to others the right to do so) the exclusive rights to broadcast, televise, reproduce, transmit and disseminate all or part of this event, and I agree that AHA may use or assign, in any way AHA sees fit, photographs, films, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the Competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the Competition or AHA. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way which implies endorsement of any company, product, product category or service. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with

endorsement of any company, product, product category or service. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation.

By signing below as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and agree to all of the above provisions, and further agree to assume all of the obligations of this AHA Assumption of Risk, Release and Indemnification personally and on behalf of the child. This AHA Assumption of Risk, Release and Indemnification is governed by the Laws of the State of Colorado and is intended to be interpreted as broadly as possible. I agree that exclusive jurisdiction and venue (place) for any legal action against AHA, its officers, directors, employees, volunteers or agents shall be in the local district courts or the federal court of the State of Colorado. If any part of this agreement is determined to be unenforceable, all other parts shall remain effect.

USEF FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulter or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc.
