AHA MEMBERSHIP CARDS & HORSE REGISTRATION PAPERS: Copies of membership cards and horse registration papers are not required to be sent with your entry since the software is linked to the AHA website. Please make certain your numbers are correct. Remember to include the prefix (1A, for example) to Half-Arabian numbers and if Canadian registered, CAHR or CPAR.

AMATEUR relationship to horse owner line on the entry is important; especially when the last name is different. Please complete it if showing in AAOTR, AOTR, or JOTR classes.

ATH MARE/GELDING CHALLENGE: See page 18 for details on this fun class, enter it and win some money! This class is open to Arabian mares and geldings & HA/AA mares and geldings. Added prize money for 2026!

BREEDING/IN HAND PADDOCK: One person per horse will be designated to assist with the entrance of the halter classes. Only that person will be allowed to use a designated whip with appendages provided by management to enhance the performance of the halter horses. These actions will only occur in the designated enhancement area. No other devices will be allowed. No one, including the designated person, will be allowed to hit or use any other objects, such as trash cans, walls, plastic signs, etc. to make additional noise. The Comparative Scoring System will be used.

PERFORMANCE FUTURITIES: The Futurity entry form is due June 1. The form is on page 15.

PAYMENT OF ENTRIES: The entry form will calculate the amount due by check or PayPal. PayPal payments to: paypal.me/Region5MR. There is a user fee of 3% added to your entry for using PayPal. The entry form will calculate 3%. Payment is due the day of entry if using PayPal. If by check, postmarked the day of entry. Entries will not be processed until payment is received.

You must replace it with cash, money order, bank check, or PayPal payment including the \$50.00 fee and any bank charges, within 5 days of notification or post entry fees will be applied to your entry. Numbers will not be released until all above conditions have been met.

POLICIES

ENTRY DATES: Entries are due via email before midnight, May 26. If snail mailed, then a postmark of May 26 or earlier.

POST ENTRY FEES: Entries made after May 26 are post entries and will be accepted up to 6PM the night before the class at the regular class fee plus \$40. There is no post entry for Lead Line.

QUALIFICATIONS are no longer required.

ENTRIES: will not be accepted over the phone or by fax. You will be informed of any discrepancies in the amount owed, including math errors, fee misunderstandings, or missing post-entry fees if your entry is postmarked after May 26, 2026. Amounts owed must be paid before numbers are released. By signing the entry form and/or submitting entries to us you agree to pay all fees due and understand refunds will not be made except for reasons listed in the refund policy below. If in doubt about fees or entry deadlines, phone the show secretary or the show manager before sending your entry. Submission of an entry to this show is your intent to show and agreement of our show rules; entries deficient in funds for any reason will not be returned to you.

ENTRY PAYMENT: Checks are to be mailed postmarked the same date as your entry is emailed. PayPal may be used. Please add 3% if you use PayPal. Payment is to be in U.S. dollars. Three entries constitute a class. Show management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes which have not filled. Show management reserves the right to reject any entry or require cash or a money order for an entry if it is in the best interest of the show. Post dated checks are not accepted. Open checks will be filled in and deposited. Credit cards are not accepted.

REFUND POLICY with a veterinarian's certificate or medical doctor's certificate if for rider until May 26 all fees except the original office fee of \$40.00 per horse. After May 26, 2026, all fees except for the \$40 Office fee. Certificates prior to June 23, email to the show secretary. **After 8 pm June 23 there will be no refund of any fees paid.**

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE: Horses are allowed on the grounds starting 12 Noon, Monday, June 22. **No early arrivals for horses or stall setup and bedding are allowed this year.** Move out is prior to 10 AM Sunday, June 28. Please check with the Show Manager, Joan Palelek. 206-972-2163 for late departure. A late departure fee of \$30 per horse will be charged.

BEDDING: Stalls will not be bedded but bedding will be supplied **as long as supply lasts.** Additional bedding may be purchased by the exhibitor locally. All stalls are matted at this facility so please bed stalls accordingly. Please do your part to conserve bedding use so we may continue our policy of having bulk bedding available.

FIRE MARSHAL RULES: By order of the Fire Marshall, all aisles between stalls must remain open. All materials used for decorative purposes must be treated with flame retardant; this includes stall drapes, even those made of cordura. Please be prepared to present evidence of this to the Snohomish County Fire Department. The Fire Marshall may inspect the show grounds. Authorized electrical appliances for grooming purposes may be used. The electrical system may not be altered or tampered with, under any circumstances. If electrical cords are used, they must be of the heavy-duty, outdoor type. Smoking is not allowed in the arenas or barn areas. Hydrants, building exits and aisle ways must remain clear of all obstructions. Decorations, signage or temporary structures may not cover or block any building exits, fire hoses, phones, or electrical panels. **Shavings may not be used in aisles or barn walkways as they are a fire hazard.**

SHARPS CONTAINERS for the disposal of needles and other sharp disposable instruments have been placed throughout the stabling area, every 50 stalls. Competition management may fine any individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$300 (\$100 USEF; \$200 Facility) for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.

STABLING: There are 402 permanent box stalls (wood or metal construction, with full doors and stall mats).

STABLING ASSIGNMENTS: A stall must be purchased for every horse or a haul-in fee paid per haul-in day. Horses may not be left in trailers overnight. Priority will be given to Patrons. After Patrons the assignment of stalls will be made as fairly as possible based on postmark of entries, number of horses, and best use of facility. No stabling changes are allowed without the consent of the barn manager. Original stabling assignments will not be changed to accommodate entries qualified after the closing date or post entries. Management will try to stable late entry as close as possible to other entries but no guarantees can be made. Decision of the show commission is final. Exhibitors wishing to be stabled together must submit their entries together in the same envelope. If you have special requests or considerations, please submit them with your entry. All requests will be considered, but no promises are implied. **Stabling preference will be given to Gold Patrons followed by Silver then Bronze Patrons.**

STALL AND BARN DAMAGE: Stalls may not be structurally altered in any way. Removal of fronts or sides to make larger areas is not allowed. Do not put nails, screws or other types of hole producing devices into the stall walls. The use of staples, tacks or tape to attach decorations to walls, buildings, stalls, etc. is prohibited. Horse hooves are not to be painted on unprotected barn floor and aisles. EXHIBITORS ARE FINANCIALLY responsible for any damage or alterations to stalls or barns and will be charged accordingly. Barns and stalls will be inspected for damage and alterations.

STALL AND BARN CLEAN-UP: Decorations/material must be removed by the exhibitor following the show. This includes any materials placed in aisles or outside barns or materials used for decorative purposes. The cost of cleanup will be \$50.00 per hour and \$9.00 per yard dumping fee for cleanup and disposal of materials other than actual stall bedding.

HERE'S WHAT YOU NEED TO COMPLETE YOUR ENTRY

- > The completed entry form, making sure all membership & registration numbers are accurate. (HA/AA include 1A or 2A)
- > The AHA/USEF Release Form (the usual one) with all required signatures. Minors cannot sign.
- > The USEF Waiver of Liability for EACH person on your entry form; one form per person. A trainer need only send one signed form.
- > If leasing or purchasing your horse on contract and showing under your ownership, then send a copy of the agreement.

ABUSE, CRUELTY & CONDUCT: All AHA and USEF rules regarding abuse, cruelty and conduct will be strictly enforced.

AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS:

EACH COMPETITOR (THIS INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE RECORDED OWNER AND ALL TRAINERS, DRIVERS, RIDERS, HALTER HANDLERS, COACHES AND THE PERSON(S) SIGNING THE ENTRY BLANK) IN AN ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION RECOGNIZED ARABIAN DIVISION, AT THE TIME OF ENTRY INTO A COMPETITION, MUST SUBMIT A COPY OF A VALID AHA MEMBERSHIP/COMPETITION CARD, JOIN AHA OR PAY AN AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP FEE PER COMPETITOR. WHEN AN AGENT SIGNS FOR THE OWNER AT AN AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITION, BOTH THE OWNER AND AGENT MUST BE MEMBERS OF AHA OR PAY THE AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP. SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP IS NOT ACCEPTABLE AT AHA REGIONAL OR NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. AATR SELECT & JTR SELECT CLASSES: Select riders may also enter AAOTR, AATR, and ATR classes if they meet the USEF owner definition. Juniors, who are Select riders, may enter JTR Select classes as well as JTR and, if owners by USEF definition, the JOTR. Please verify your status on the AHA website, www.arabianhorses.org.

AMATEUR OWNER FAMILY/UNRELATED OWNER DEFINITION: Registration papers of horses entered in amateur owner and junior owner classes must in the name of the competitor or a member of the competitor's family or if unrelated owners then the following rule applies: two non-related owners are now able to co-own and show in owner classes IF 1) the ownership is an AND ownership not an OR ownership 2) no family member of a professional may enter into this relationship 3) "non family owners" are defined as two distinct individuals who are not related as family as defined by USEF or EC. 4) the horse must be registered with one of the five Registries in US or Canada or another approved registry. 5) family members of these two co-owners are NOT permitted to show in owner classes. 6) both co-owners must be members of USEF or EC and hold valid amateur cards. 7) co-ownership is limited to two distinct individuals – no farms or business entities. Please see USEF AR110.4.e for complete requirements and limitations. Horses registered in a farm, ranch, syndicate, partnership or corporation name may be shown in Amateur Owner classes provided the family is the sole owner of the farm or entity as defined by USEF rules.) The sale of a horse does not eliminate this registration requirement. Contracts of Sale or Bill of Sale will not be accepted for owner classes.

ARENAS: Arena footing is sandy loam or sand. Measurements are: Main arena – 120' x 248', Covered Warm-up – 100' x 200', Front sand ring – 128' x 254', NE sand ring – 130' x 200', sand ring between barns 105/106 – 73' x 164'. Several sand lunge rings are available.

AWARDS: Champions and Reserve Champions will have a choice of prizes. Champions and Reserve Champions will also receive a neck garland and neck ribbon. Top Fives will receive a prize and a ribbon. Top Five: A full Top Five will be awarded regardless of the number of entries in a class. However, only awards made to the top 50% of the class (rounded up and not to exceed 5 awards) will receive Arabian Breeders Sweepstakes payouts, AHA Horse Achievement Awards, Amateur Achievement Awards, High Point Horse Achievement Awards, High Point Amateur Achievement Awards and Distance Award points.

AWARDS ROOM: Located inside the main arena by the out-gate. All awards must be picked up and signed for at the awards area. The awards area will be open during class sessions. Unclaimed awards will not be mailed.

BIKES, MOPEDS, ROLLERBLADES, RAZORS, SCOOTERS are not allowed inside the fairground's fences per fairgrounds rules.

BREEDING/GELDING IN-HAND CLASSES: Regional classes will be conducted using the "In the Ring Class Procedure" with horses entering by birth date, oldest to youngest, including post entries. The "Comparative System" as outlined in the AHA Handbook will be used. Please see the FYI page for important halter class entrance information.

CLASS CONFLICTS: Exhibitors are cautioned against entering the same horse in successive classes. Due to full schedules, the gate will not be held for riders beyond the normal gate hold allowed. No refunds will be given due to class conflicts.

General Rules & Info, cont'd

DOGS: Must be on a leash (except when in RV's) and under control at all times. They are not allowed inside arenas, rings or lunging areas or restrooms. Owners must clean up after their dog. The Gate Attendant will report to the show office if there are any issues with dogs running free or aggressive dogs. Stalls may not be used as dog kennels/pens.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW: FROM THE SOUTH: I-5 North then merge onto I-405 N via exit 154 toward Renton and Bellevue. Merge onto WA 522 East via Exit 23 toward US 2 to Woodinville/Wenatchee. Turn right onto US 2. Turn right onto 179th Ave SE. The trailer entrance is approximately .3 mile on right. **FROM THE NORTH:** I-5 South to Seattle then merge onto I-405 S via exit 182 to Bellevue/Renton. Merge onto WA522 East via Exit 23A toward WA 202/Monroe/Wenatchee. Turn right onto US 2/ Stevens Pass Hwy. Turn right onto 179th Ave SE. The trailer entrance is approximately .3 mile on the right.

DRUGS & MEDICATION: Refer to USEF Chapter 4. The official Medication Report Forms are to be completed online at www.usef.org.

FEED: Feed is available from area retailers. Check at the office for information.

FOOD: Food and beverages will be available from concessions on the fairgrounds during show hours.

GATE: When it is found that a gate hold must be requested by an exhibitor, such request shall be made to the Paddock Master prior to the close of judging of the class immediately before the class requiring the gate hold. The reason for the request must be stated. The gate-hold will be a maximum of three (3) minutes. Appropriate warning will be given to all exhibitors if there is a gate hold in effect. **When horses are competing collectively, if a first horse does not enter the in-gate ready to participate within one minute from when the class is called into the ring, a warning is issued.** a. Exhibitors will then have one additional minute to start the steady stream of horses into the in-gate. b. If no horses have entered the gate at the conclusion of the additional one minute, the gate shall be closed and the class is deemed concluded. c. Once the first horse has entered the in-gate, a steady stream of horses must be maintained. d. Should the steady stream be broken after the two minutes have elapsed, the gate shall be closed and judging will commence. e. A steady stream is defined as a constant flow of horses moving forward through the in-gate with a reasonable and safe distance between them (i.e. two to four horse or horse and buggy lengths in between). f. **Show Management in conjunction with the Steward may deviate from this procedure as circumstances warrant.** A starting order will be established in all classes in which horses compete individually and one minute allowed for an entry to enter the ring.

GOLF CARTS: Are allowed with proof of insurance on file in the show office. Please read and comply with the USEF Motorized vehicles rule below. Please park in golf cart designated areas.

LUNGING: Lunging areas will be provided. Please look for "Lunging Allowed" signs. Lunging is not allowed in the main ring, the covered outdoor ring, the front sand ring, or the NE sand ring.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a temporary license may operate the above-described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. **See more Golf Cart information above on this page.**

OFFICE: The show office is located at the North end of the main arena. The office may be closed during meal hours. Office hours are as follows: June 23 from 11 AM – 9 PM, June 24 – June 29 from 7:30 AM until 30 minutes after the last class.

OPEN CHECKS: In fairness to all exhibitors, open checks are not allowed for the initial entry. Open checks may be left for adding items when packets are picked up at the show office. The Show Secretary reserves the right to finalize any check left open, either for initial or final.

PARKING: Parking is not allowed in the fenced fairgrounds area. Please be courteous and unload in a timely manner and move your rigs to the parking areas.

PRIZE MONEY: AHA Sweepstakes monetary awards will be paid by AHA in accordance with program rules. Sweepstakes program information may be found in the 2026 AHA Handbook. Prize money for Classes 640 The A/HA/AA Mare/Gelding ATH Challenge and 689 the A/HA/AA Ranch Disciplined Rail Pleasure will be paid by check at the show.

General Rules & Info, cont'd

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR: All juniors riding in hunter, jumper and hunter seat equitation sections, while riding anywhere on the competition grounds, must wear properly fitted protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM/SEI standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place. Any exhibitor may wear protective headgear (ASTM/SEI) and/or a protective safety vest, specifically designed for use in equestrian sport in any division or class without penalty from the judge. The Federation recommends that the vest meet or surpass the current ASTM standard or be certified by the Safety Equipment Institute..

RV/LQ/CAMPING: Reservations will be taken by the fairgrounds beginning May 18. Please reserve and pay by phone 360-805-6706. Let them know the length of your rig and if you have a tip-out. If more than one space is taken, you will be charged for two. Prices are \$50 per night for a full hook-up (must be approved by Joan before reserving with fairgrounds) and \$42 per night for water/electric or taking a spot for camping. All RV hook-ups to be paid to the ESF when making the reservation.

SCORING SYSTEMS: The Comparative System will be used for all Breeding/Gelding In-Hand classes. The AHA approved Majority Opinion System (MOS) will be used for all classes except Regional Trail, Reining, Ranch Horse Riding and Reining Seat Equitation classes which will be judged by a single judge.

STALL CLEANING: The past few years, our facility contract has made the show responsible for cleaning stalls after the show and we build the cost into the cost of the stall. Last year, a Snohomish County 4-H club was hired to do the work. They have agreed to do the job again but let us know that many stalls were left with large amounts of dirty, wet shavings. It appears instead of cleaning daily, fresh shavings were added to the top every day, leaving large amounts of dirty, strong ammonia smelling shavings. This unfairly exposed the 4 H'ers to an unsafe breathing environment in a hot, enclosed area. Please clean your stalls daily and use fewer shavings to help us reduce the cost of stalls, shavings, cleaning and removal from the fairgrounds. We realize more shavings are used when supplied bulk. We are hopeful we can continue providing bulk shavings and still have a group willing to do the job of cleaning. This year, we will again receive a list of those who leave excessive amounts of dirty, wet shavings and will add a \$30 cleaning charge to the account of the horse owner. Show management will determine if stalls have been over-bedded. Stalls are not to be used as a dog kennel for the same reasons.

STALLIONS: Stallions may be shown in any class except for Walk/Trot/Jog 10 & under, Junior Ex. Showmanship & Lead Line.

SUBSTITUTION OF JUDGES: Region 5 reserves the right to substitute or re-assign judges if the need arises.

VACCINATION RULE: effective 12/01/15, all horses competing at a USEF recognized show must have proof of current vaccinations for rhino and flu. Exhibitors must furnish proof upon the request of show management.

USEF MEMBERSHIP: Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes

USEF NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION: A non-member may purchase a Show Pass once per year for one show only and must make the purchase on-line at www.usef.org. Purchase of a Show Pass fee does NOT allow a competitor to show in amateur classes. To show in an amateur class, a competitor must provide proof of a competing membership with amateur certification. More info: <https://www.usef.org/faqs/usef-show-pass>

USEF MEMBERSHIP FOR PARENTS SIGNING FOR A MINOR TRAINER: A parent or guardian who signs the entry releases for a minor trainer must now have a Competing Membership and complete and be current with Safe Sport Training.

USEF SAFE SPORT POLICY: As of January 1, 2019, if you are a USEF competing member 18 years of age or older you are required to take the core Safe Sport Training within 30 days of activating your membership. Take the Safe Sport Training at www.USEF.org by logging into your member dashboard. Please remember to complete the most recent required course before your due date. Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirements to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org. Any questions not answered by the website should be directed to USEF at 859.810-8733.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS & USEF: EC Sport License holders in good standing and with a Bronze, Silver, Gold, or Platinum Sport License (non-FEI disciplines and breeds) will be given a USEF Competing Membership at no cost for the purpose of competing in USEF-licensed competitions. All USEF Competing Members who are 18 years of age or older must annually complete the SafeSport Training provided by the U.S. Center for Safe Sport before being allowed to compete. ***This USEF issued number is to be used on your entry form.*** For information about obtaining a USEF Competition membership, EC Sport License holders should contact sportlicences@equestrian.ca or memberservices@usef.org. USEF rules for amateur status apply for all competitions licensed by USEF, and EC rules for amateur status apply for all competitions sanctioned by EC. ***This is the number you will need for your entry forms.***

It is important to note that individuals holding dual memberships (both USEF and EC) must complete the education requirements for both National Federations.

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AWWA RANCH DISCIPLINED RAIL PLEASURE

The AWWA is proud to introduce a new Ranch class to serve the needs of an expanding exhibitor base. Entries will be shown and judged in accordance to the Ranch Rail Appointments and Conduct (AR242) as set forth in the Arabian Division of the USEF Rule Book. The Class Procedure for Ranch Discipline Rail Pleasure is noted below.

CLASS PROCEDURE:

The purpose of the AWWA Ranch Disciplined Rail Pleasure class is to show the ability of a well-trained Ranch Horse to be used as a work partner and companion. Horse should be willingly guided with smooth transitions and quality movements.

Judging shall be based on the best overall ranch disciplined rail performance. The class is not a game, nor a fault and out elimination class. Horses must not be over-worked. Safety of horse and rider are of first- priority.

1. Each horse enters the arena individually at the trot proceeding up centerline. At mid-point, they will extend the trot to the end of the arena. At the end of the arena exhibitors turn left or right at the direction of the ring master and proceed down the long wall. Before reaching the in-gate exhibitors will transition to the walk and halt. Horses are to stand quietly as each exhibitor enters the arena.

2. When all exhibitors have performed the individual entry maneuver the call judge will work horses on the rail as a group at the walk, trot, and lope both directions of the ring. An extension of any gait may be called.

3. Exhibitors will be asked to perform additional work. Work may include, but it not limited to:

- a. Hand gallop
- b. Flying or Simple change of lead
- c. Halt & stand quietly on rail
- d. Side pass either to left or right
- e. Turn on hind quarters
- f. Turn on forehand
- g. Starting into lope from a halt
- h. Extension of any gait

4. Upon completion of rail work, horses will be lined-up side-by-side in center of arena. Individually, exhibitors will ride forward from line, turn a 360 in either direction, and then back into the original place in line.

The AWWA Ranch Discipline Rail Pleasure class will be offered at the 2026 Youth/Mid-Summer Nationals show in Oklahoma City, OK.

Horses nominated to the AWWA Incentive Fund will receive bonus prize money.

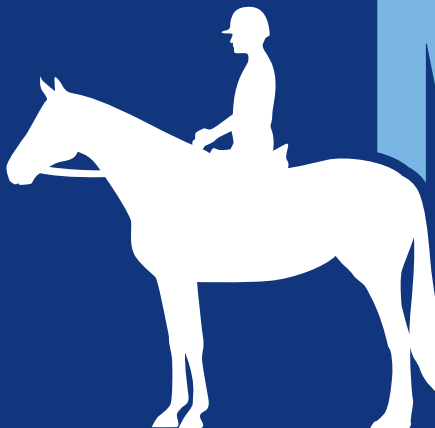

In consideration for AHA permitting me to participate in this Competition, and by signing the entry blank, I agree as follows:

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in this Competition, as a rider, driver, handler, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, junior exhibitor, or as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. **I AM FULLY AWARE AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HORSE SPORTS AND PARTICIPATION IN THIS COMPETITION INVOLVE SERIOUS RISK OF HARM INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RISKS OF ACCIDENT, SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, BROKEN BONES, HEAD INJURIES, TRAUMA, PAIN, AND SUFFERING, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE. I ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM TO ME, MY HORSE OR MY PROPERTY.**

I AGREE as a Horse Show Participant (or Parent/Guardian of Participant if a minor) to waive all claims which may otherwise arise from, including but not limited to infectious bacteria, viruses, fungi/mold, parasites or other agents which may be present at the Horse Show (and most other outdoor locations) and can cause infection in humans, as well as in animals.
