POSITIONS & EXPECTATIONS



REGIONAL YOUTH DIRECTOR

- Elected or appointed by regional youth, Regional Youth Coordinator, or Regional Director
- 1 year (August–July) term, can serve more than one term
- Sits on AHYA Board with voting power
- Attends at least two AHYA Board Meetings
- Runs at least one regional meeting a year (at some point during the year, the Regional Director must get as many youth as possible together to have a meeting to talk about what is happening in the region and if they would like to see any changes made or have any new ideas)
- Encourages and runs youth activities in local region (ex – fundraisers to support travel to board meetings, activities to encourage friendships and comradery)
- Works with Regional Youth Coordinator on ways to increase youth participation and fundraise to pay for travel to AHYA Board meetings
- Participate/volunteer at the Cascade Youth Benefit Show and other local events.
- Secure a \$100 sponsorship for the Cascade Youth Benefit Show.



REGIONAL YOUTH VICE DIRECTOR

- Assist Director in the running of Board meetings.
- Participate in Regional Youth conference calls and meetings.
- Communicate regularly with Regional Youth Coordinator.
- Identify a project to take the lead on and manage.
- If director can not attend an AHYA board meeting, then the Vice Director will attend on their behalf and have voting power.
- Attend AHYA meetings when requested by Regional Coordinator via zoom to hear what is happening on a national level.
- Participate/volunteer at the Cascade Youth Benefit Show and other local events.
- Secure a \$100 sponsorship for the Cascade Youth Benefit Show.



REGIONAL YOUTH SECRETARY

- Take minutes during Board meetings, send minutes to Youth Coordinator and Youth Director following meetings.
- Participate in meetings and conference calls.
- Communicate regularly with Regional Youth Coordinators, Regional Directors, Youth Committee.
- Identify a project to take the lead on and manage.
- Attend AHYA meetings when requested by Regional Coordinator via zoom to hear what is happening on a national level.
- Participate/volunteer at the Cascade Youth Benefit Show and other local events.
- If the director and vice director cannot attend a meeting, then you may be called upon to attend a meeting or lead a meeting locally.
- Secure a \$100 sponsorship for the Cascade Youth Benefit Show.



TREASURER

- Advise the Board on the status of the AHYA budget with advising from the Youth Coordinator.
- Participate in conference calls and meetings.
- Communicate regularly with Regional Youth Coordinators, Regional Directors, Youth Committee.
- Identify a project to take the lead on and manage.
- Participate/volunteer at the Cascade Youth Benefit Show and other local events.
- Secure a \$100 sponsorship for the Cascade Youth Benefit Show.
